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The 28th Annual Siskiyou Century

The Century (103 Miles) Climb from Yreka (2,595 ft.) over Forest Mountain (4,097 ft.) and descend into Scott Valley. Next climb Gazelle Mountain (4,921 ft.) The final leg follows the western edge of Shasta Valley as it leads back to Yreka. Approximately 4,600 feet of climbing.

The Metric Century (64 Miles) From Yreka (2,595 ft.) to the historic Montague, then through the Little Shasta Valley, then to Lake Shastina, Gazelle, and then to Yreka. Approximately 1,500 feet of climbing.

The Metric 1/2 Century (37 Miles) Riders will head from Yreka to Montague, then out through Little Shasta Valley From there, return to Yreka. Approximately 600 feet of climbing.

All Riders: Riders must finish the course by 5:30 PM or our last sweep will bring you into the fairgrounds for check-in. The carnival rest room showers will be available until 6 pm. Riders must furnish their own towels.

Pre-registrants and Packet Pickup: Friday, Sept. 11th at the fairgrounds from 5 P.M. to 7 P.M. and the starting area Sept. 12th. If you register after the Sept. 8th deadline, a \$5.00 late fee will be required.

Lodging: For information, the Chamber of Commerce office (www.yrechamber.com) can send it to you. We will have RV hookups at the fairgrounds for \$15.00 Fri. night, and tent camping for \$13.00 Fri. night. The fairgrounds will be open on Saturday. The fee includes water, electricity, showers and toilets.

In consideration of my acceptance for entry in the SISKIYOU CENTURY for 2015, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury, or property damage which I may have, or which hereafter may accrue to me, as a result of my participation in said event.

This release is intended to discharge in advance the promoters, sponsors, and any involved municipalities or other public entities and their respective agents and employees, from and against any and all liabilities arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in said event, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above.

I further understand that this event will require me to engage in strenuous physical activity at high altitude and in possible adverse weather conditions. I further understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during bicycle riding and the participants in bicycle riding occasionally sustain mortal or serious physical injury, and/or property damage, as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risk of bicycle riding, nevertheless, I hereby agree to assume these risks and to release and hold harmless all persons or entities mentioned above who (through negligence or carelessness) might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs or assigns) for damages.

It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk, is to be binding on my heirs and assigns. I further agree to abide by all the rules and regulations set forth in this event. I acknowledge that an approved helmet is required to be worn by me at all times while riding during these events. Section 1542 of the civil code of the state of California which provides: a general release does not extend to claim which the creditors do not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known to him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor, and all laws of all other states of like, or similar affect, and the benefits thereof are hereby waived.

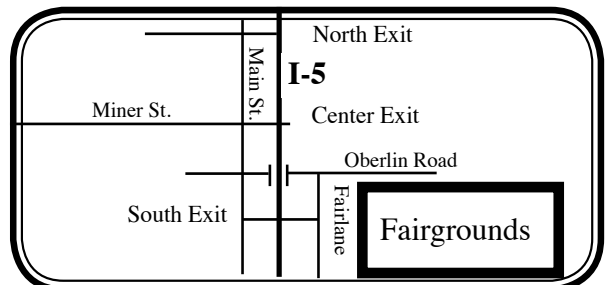
